Secondary School Principal

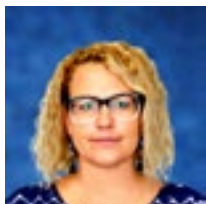

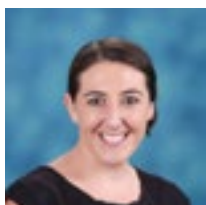
Leanne Harvey

In her spare time, Susan likes to dance Argentine tango.



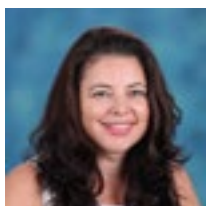
Tamara Snooks

Yolaine Johanson

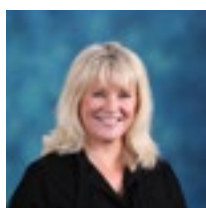

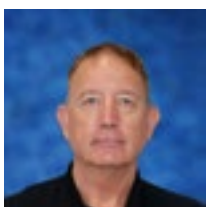
Lucy Ashdown
