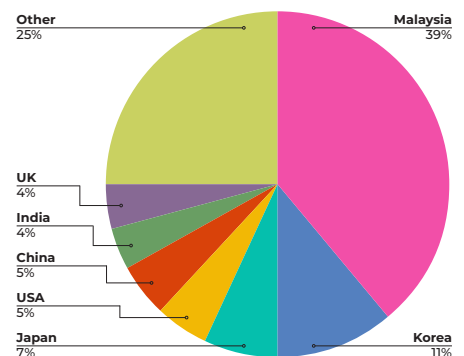

COVID-19 Impact. Malaysian schools have been intermittently closed for face-to-face learning during the 2019-2020 and 2020-2021 academic years due to the ongoing national "Movement Control Order". Fully online school periods include October 14 - December 18, 2020, May 14 - June 10, 2021 & August 11 - October 1, 2021. The full day online learning program was designed to meet the needs of student learning and well-being. Classes were conducted synchronously and academic reporting remained unchanged. The IGBIS Counselling team conducted regular wellness and academic check-ins to support student learning.

ACADEMIC PATHWAYS AT IGBIS



- 6 subject groups.
- External assessment (examinations).
- Teacher assessment externally monitored.

The IB Diploma Programme is the basis of study for the final two years at IGBIS. Students must take 6 subjects. One subject must be selected from each of the following groups:

- Group 1 Language A.
- Group 2 Language B.
- Group 3 Individuals and Societies.
- Group 4 Experimental Sciences.
- Group 5 Mathematics.
- Group 6 Electives + Arts.



- At least 2-4 DP courses
- CP Core that includes Service Learning, Personal and Professional Skills, Language Development, and a Reflective Project
- University level credits from Savannah College of Art and Design (Art and Design stream)

IB Career-related students undertaking the Art and Design stream are expected to do DP Mathematics SL or High School Mathematics, English A or English B and may choose to do two other subjects.

HIGH SCHOOL DIPLOMA REQUIREMENTS

- Successfully achieve 24 credits over 4 years of study (1 subject = 1 credit per year).
- Complete all credit requirements. Satisfy the school attendance policy.
- Satisfy the school HSD core requirements.
- (CAS, Reflective Project & Extended Essay).

INTERPRETING IB GRADES AND TRANSCRIPTS

A student's examination performance in individual subjects is scored on a scale of 1-7 points with 7 as the highest, and a further 3 points available based on a matrix of performance in Theory of Knowledge (ToK) and the Extended Essay components. Students who meet all assessment requirements and achieve a minimum of 24 points (out of a possible 45) are awarded the IB Diploma. IB grades and courses are not weighted. IGBIS does not rank its students or provide percentile or decile information.

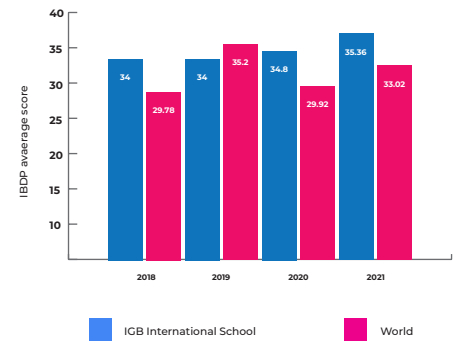
