








#### POST-SECONDARY PLANS, CLASS OF 2022



## **INTERPRETING IB GRADES AND TRANSCRIPTS**

- $\cdot$  All students are graded on a 1 7 grading scale. 3 is the minimum passing grade.
- · Grades and courses are not weighted.
- · Credits are awarded on a .5 system over 2 semesters.
- · Transcripts are updated twice a year: January and June.
- · IGBIS does not rank its students or provide percentile or decile information.
- · IGBIS does not convert grades to a GPA.

IBDP Pathway: A student's examination performance in individual subjects is scored on a scale of 1-7 points with 7 as the highest, and a further 3 points available based on a matrix of performance in Theory of Knowledge (ToK) and the Extended Essay components. Students who meet all assessment requirements and achieve a minimum of 24 points (out of a possible 45) are awarded the IB Diploma.
