IGBIS at a Glance

- Founded in 2014.
- Students from Early Years to Grade 12, ages 2 to 18.
- Independent, private, day school.
- State-of-the-art facilities on a 10-acre campus.
- Purpose-built learning spaces to meet the needs of future learning and skills development.

Academics

- IB PYP, MYP, DP and CP, and IGBIS High School Diploma (HSD)
- Four high school pathways are offered: IBDP, IBCP, HSD+ DP Courses, and HSD.
- All students must meet the requirements for the HS Diploma to graduate.
- 42 High School subjects, including IBDP higher and standard level subjects.
- IBCP is offered in collaboration with SCAD (Savannah College of Art and Design), ERAU (Embry-Riddle Aeronautical University), SUMAS (Sustainability Management School), WAoS (World Academy of Sport).
- Semester reporting system; transcripts updated in January and June
- Credits awarded in .5 increments
- Creativity, activity, service (CAS) and service-learning programmes engage students domestically and internationally.
- 25 Wellness blocks for all secondary students (grades 6 -12) per academic year.
- 180 teacher-student contact days within two semesters.

- Everton FC International Academy at IGB International School offers access to elite-level coaching for students and the wider community.

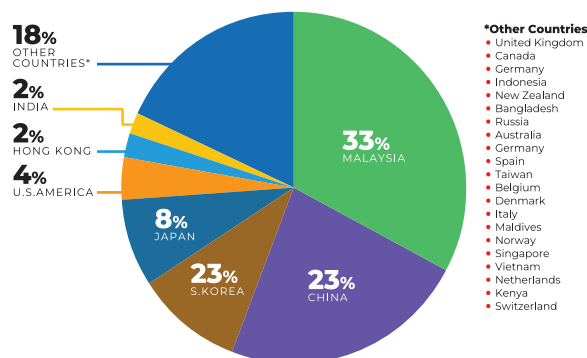

High School Diploma Requirements

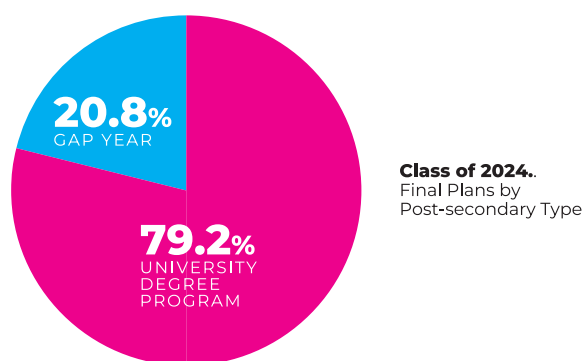
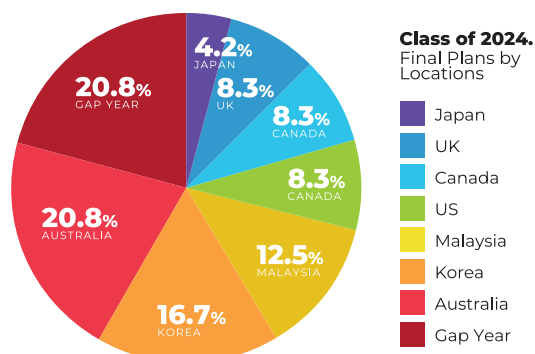
- Successfully achieve 24 credits over 4 years of study.

- Satisfy the school HSD core requirements (CAS, Reflective Project & Extended Essay).

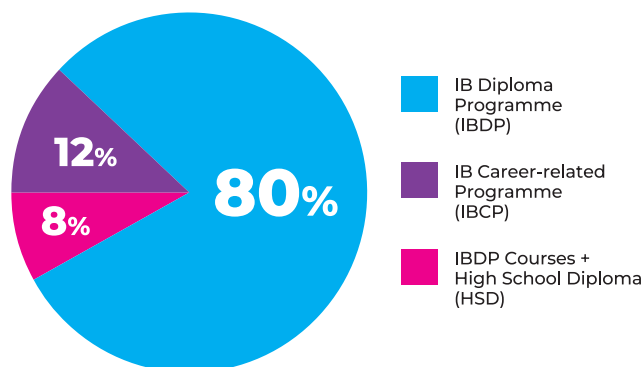

Post-Secondary Plans, Class of 2024

- 100% of students graduated with a post-secondary plan.
- 50% of students entered post-secondary education or military service directly after graduation.
- 29% awaiting admissions decisions worldwide.
- 21% of students took a gap year.



IGBIS Pathways



Interpreting Grades and Transcripts

- All students are graded on a 1 - 7 grading scale; 3 is the minimum passing grade.
- Grades and courses are not weighted.
- Credits are awarded on a .5 system over 2 semesters.
- Transcripts are updated twice a year: January and June.
- IGBIS does not rank its students or provide percentile or decile information.
- IGBIS does not convert grades to a GPA.

IBDP Pathway: A student's examination performance in individual subjects is scored on a scale of 1-7 points with 7 as the highest, and a further 3 points available based on a matrix of performance in Theory of Knowledge (ToK) and the Extended Essay components. Students who meet all assessment requirements and achieve a minimum of 24 points (out of a possible 45) are awarded the IB Diploma.

Academic Pathways at IGBIS



- 6 DP Courses External standardised assessments (examinations).
- Teacher assessments are externally monitored.
- In-depth knowledge of academic writing.
- Explore the nature of knowledge through the 'Theory of Knowledge (TOK)'.
- Explore passions and develop talents through the Creativity, Activity, Service programme.
- International outlook through intercultural skills.

The IB Diploma Programme is the basis of study for the final two years at IGBIS. Students must take 6 subjects. One subject must be selected from the following groups:

- Group 1 Language A.
- Group 2 Language B or Language A*
- Group 3 Individuals and Societies.
- Group 4 Experimental Sciences.
- Group 5 Mathematics.
- Group 6 Electives + Arts.

*Students with 2 Language A subjects receive a Bilingual diploma.

The IB Career-related Programme is the basis of study for the final two years at IGBIS. Students must take 2-4 DP courses from the following groups:

- Group 1 Language A (English A or B is mandatory*)
- Group 2 Language B (English A or B is mandatory*)
- Group 3 Individuals and Societies.
- Group 4 Experimental Sciences.
- Group 5 Mathematics (Mandatory*)
- Group 6 Electives + Arts.

*Students are expected to take Mathematics, English A or English B and may choose one or two other subjects.

There are 4 Dual Enrolment programmes within the IBCP offered at IGBIS:

- **Art and Design** in collaboration with Savannah College of Art and Design in the USA.
- **Aeronautics and Engineering** with Embry-Riddle Aeronautical University in the USA.
- **Sustainability Management** with Sustainability Management School in Switzerland.
- **Sport Management** with World Academy of Sport.

Art and Design

In addition to the DP courses, students take 5 University courses from Savannah College of Art and Design, which are sequences in the following possible academic pathways:

- General and Liberal Arts
- Digital Media
- Advertising and Branding

- Graphic Design
- Interactive Design and Game Development
- Photography
- Sequential Art
- Business of Beauty and Fragrance
- Fashion Marketing and Management



Aeronautics and Engineering

In addition to the DP courses, students complete University courses from Embry-Riddle, which are sequences in the following possible academic pathways:

- Aeronautics
- Aviation Maintenance and Business
- Engineering Fundamentals
- Core
- Science, Technology, Engineering and Math (STEM)
- Unmanned Systems

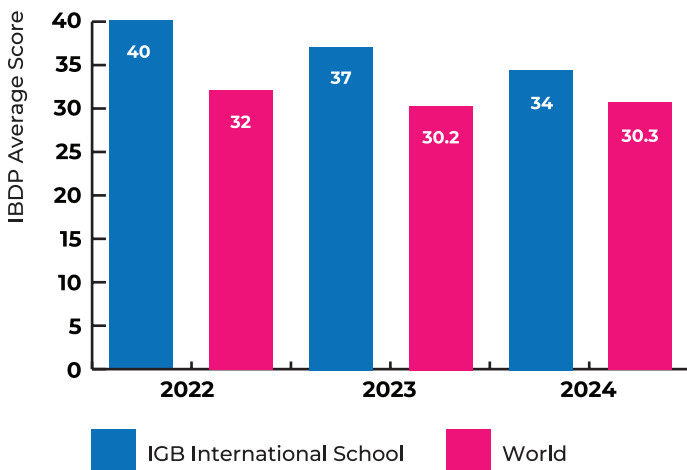
Sport Management
